DIVES scholarships:

- cover costs relating to vocational education and training (VET) and university studies relevant to defence industry careers' including tuition and other compulsory fees, textbooks and equipment;
- provide career planning support to identify training or further study leading to defence industry career pathways; and
- offer free face to face professional and practical advice on career, training and employment pathways specific to defence industry occupations.

This program is open to ex-serving Australian Defence Force (ADF) members; ADF members in active or inactive reserve forces; and current ADF serving members about to transition/separate within three to six months.
