Infrastructure Ready Program

Do you have a positive attitude and work well in teams? Are you interested in joining more than 13,000 workers to construct major projects such as METRONET and the Bunbury Outer Ring Road?

Get job ready - apply now!

Be part of State Government's \$6.5 billion unprecedented building program to be spent on major road and rail infrastructure over the next two years.

Complete the online form, which will give you an opportunity to find out more about the program and to tell us a bit about you.

This program is FREE* for concession-eligible students.

Attend three weeks of intensive full time training (4–5 days per week)

The three-week short course training teaches:

- work safety practices (including White Card);
- carry out measurements and calculations;
- how to prepare and organise construction work; and
- skills to operate equipment and tools needed in construction projects.

Attend a four-day work placement with an employer

During your work placement, you will:

- gain real, hands on industry experience; and
- secure a 'foot in the door' by working with an employer.

Complete the program and become **job ready** to join the civil construction workforce

By completing the Infrastructure Ready Program, you may:

- be offered a job with your work placement employer;
- be offered a traineeship in civil construction;
- gain employer references; or
- be endorsed for other employment opportunities within the civil construction industry.
