WHAT WE FOUND:

Strong agreement for rapid and targeted training responses to address skill and workforce needs of the State in **5** key areas with **46** recommendations:

- New futures for Western Australians** – Help people into new careers (**14** recommendations)
- 21st century apprenticeships** – Reform apprenticeships and traineeships to create trades for the future (**8** recommendations)
- Maximising skills from Government investment** – Lift the number of apprentices and trainees employed through Government projects (**3** recommendations)
- Live-learn-work in regional WA** – Train locals and attract more skilled workers to the regions (**7** recommendations)
- Next generation training** – Reposition TAFE sector capability to meet the needs of WA industry and community (**14** recommendations)



REVIEW OF SKILLS, TRAINING AND WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT



HOW THE STATE GOVERNMENT IS RESPONDING:

- \$229.2 million** Rebuilding our TAFEs plan, including
 - \$57 million** recovery package for WA TAFE and training sector
 - \$167.4 million** investment in capital works program for state of the art TAFE teaching and learning around the State, **creating around 1,000 jobs**
 - \$4.8 million** Apprenticeship and Traineeship Reengagement incentive



WHEN THE RECOMMENDATIONS WILL BE IMPLEMENTED:

- ✓ **6** recommendations implemented on 1 July 2020
- ✓ **37** recommendations to be progressed in the first phase of recovery – July to December 2020
- ✓ **3** recommendations to be considered through the State Recovery Plan's Reforming and Transforming phase
- ✓ **14** capital works projects approved and progressing

INITIATIVES ALREADY IMPLEMENTED:



- ✓ **15** free job ready skill set courses
- ✓ **6** free infection control skill set courses
- ✓ **39** more *Lower fees, local skills* courses with fees slashed by up to 72%
- ✓ Apprenticeship and Traineeship Reengagement incentive for employers (\$6,000 for apprentices; \$3,000 for trainees)
- ✓ Free training for displaced apprentices and trainees
- ✓ Free out of contract register for displaced apprentices and trainees
