This free *Infection control skill set* will allow you to upskill in organisational infection prevention and control policies and procedures.

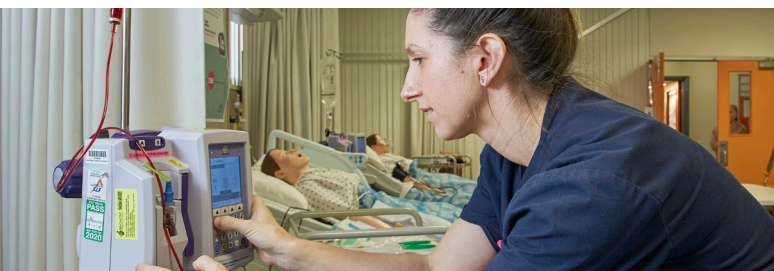
