Overview

The COVID-19 Direct Care Skill Set will teach you the skills and knowledge required to reduce the risk and transmission of infection in the workplace.

You will learn how to comply with infection control policies and procedures; conduct manual tasks safely; and to meet the personal support needs for people you are caring for.

The skill set is suited to those working in aged care, disability support, nursing assistance, home and community care and at home care. Skills can be applied to specific industry needs such as identifying the basis of infection from viruses to bacteria and modes of transmission, and infection prevention and control – including the correct use of personal protective equipment and handling contaminated waste.
